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




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Avg. annual \$ single family loans per unit of single family housing (2011-15)

More than 20,000 African American residents were displaced from low-income neighborhoods from 2000 to 2013, researchers say.

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



Figure 3: National distribution of cities with the number of tracts (neighborhoods) undergoing gentrification 2000-2013.
