- No non-functional turf:
  - Nevada: Assembly Bill 356
    - SNWA has prohibited grass lawn in the front yard (2005) and now the backyard (2021); there has not been any impact to the housing market.

  - Castle Rock, CO: no turf in front yards of new homes and backyard irrigated turf limited to 500 sf
  - California: Assembly Bill 1572, adopted 10-2023

    - The use of potable water for the irrigation of nonfunctional turf located on commercial, industrial, and institutional properties, other than a cemetery, and on properties of homeowners' associations, common interest developments, and community service organizations or similar entities is prohibited as of the following dates:
      - All properties owned by local governments, local or regional public agencies, and public water systems, beginning January 1, 2027;
      - All other institutional properties and all commercial and industrial properties, beginning January 1, 2028;
      - All common areas of properties of homeowners' associations, common interest developments, and community service organizations or similar entities, beginning January 1, 2029; and
      - All properties owned by local governments, local public agencies, and public water systems in a disadvantaged community, beginning January 1, 2031, or the date upon which a state funding source is made available to fund conversion of nonfunctional turf on these properties to climateappropriate landscapes, whichever is later.
- Scottsdale, Arizona: banned natural grass in the front yards of new homes built or permitted after August 15th, 2023
